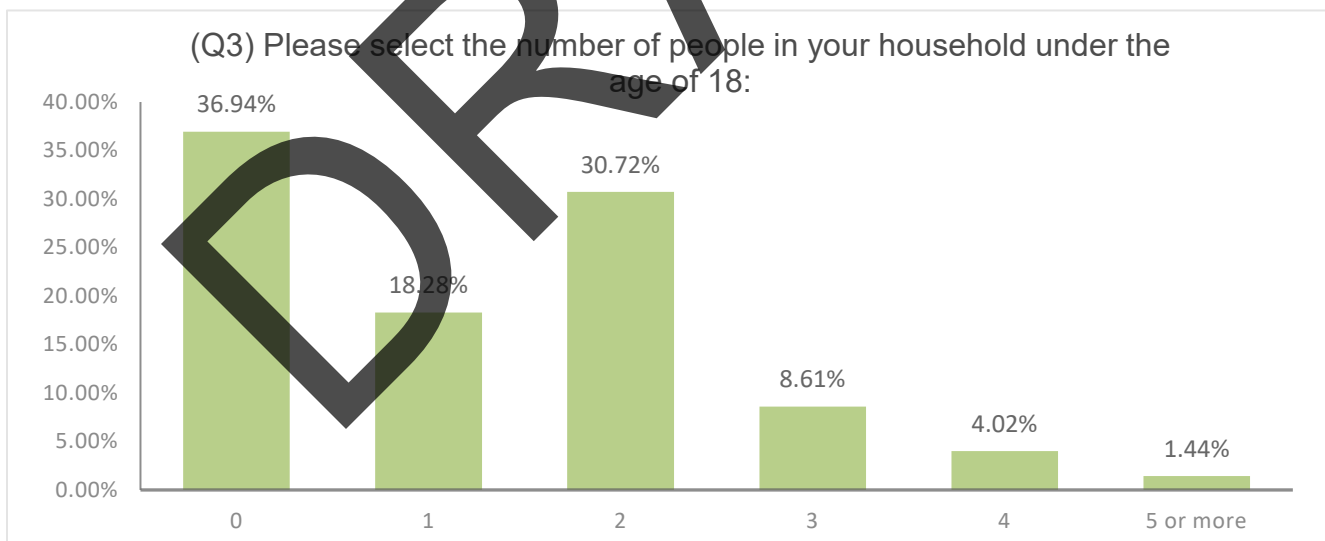


Question 2 (Q2) of the survey asked respondents to enter their age. The largest respondent age group was the 45-64-year-old age group (48%). Of the 1046 respondents that answered this question, 28% were in the 25-44-year-old age group, 21% were in the 65+ age group, 2% were in the under-18 age group, and 1% were in the 18-24-year-old age group. According to the ACS 2021 5-year estimate, 26.8% of the 45-64-year-old, 22.1% 25-44-year-old age group, and 21.2% of the 65+ age group make up the largest cohorts in Hastings-on-Hudson¹. This indicates that the age of the respondents who completed the survey closely represents the Villages population. The Village has a larger senior population than the surrounding Villages (Dobbs Ferry and Ardsley). This will impact the needs of each demographic. Further illustrated in Question 3 (Q3).

Question 3 (Q3) of the survey asked respondents to select the number of people in their household under the age of 18. This question allows the Village to better understand the youth population growing up in Hastings-on-Hudson. Subsequently, the responses indicate that 36.94% of the 1045 respondents have no one in their household below the age of 18. At a close second, 30.72% of people have two (2) people under 18 in their household. The mix of families and a larger senior population is likely consistent with the Village being in proximity to New York City [i.e., proximity to work, slower pace].
